Metabolic syndrome (MetS) is a clustering of metabolic complications representing a pre-morbid condition that is a substantial public health burden. Animal models provide an opportunity to examine correlations among different metabolic parameters to understand why metabolic complications sometimes cluster and sometimes do not. This chapter provides an overview of animal models of MetS that are used to understand etiology and pathophysiology, with a focus on methods of identifying and testing candidate genes with the aim of translating results to human studies. Genetic, epigenetic, environmental, and gene by environmental methods and results are discussed along with important lessons learned. Rodent models are the most frequently used, however other animal models including dogs, pigs, sheep, and non-human primates have contributed to our understanding of MetS and each are discussed.

Additionally, animal models used to test physiological hypotheses are reviewed along with their potential to illuminate DNA sequence-metabolic function relationships to inform therapies. Chapter 11 bankruptcy cases will drag on interminably if judges let them. The recent nine-month O.J. Simpson trial was short compared to the careers of some chapter 11 bankruptcy cases. The typical duration of chapter 11 cases can be reduced remarkably, however, through moderate judicial case management. The data in this study show that relatively modest judicial case management can squeeze a substantial amount of delay out of chapter 11 cases within the context of the present bankruptcy law. The case management program in this study, applied to 81.2% of the chapter 11 case load, shortened by 24.1% the time to confirmation of a chapter 11 plan in a typical case; it reduced by 44.1% the time to conversion to a case under another chapter of the Bankruptcy Code; and it shortened by 53.5% the time to dismissal of a typical nonviable chapter 11 case. The overall time until disposition of a chapter 11 case was diminished by 45.4%. While these remarkable results were obtained, the impact of the outcome of the cases was rather modest. There was a slight increase in the rate of plan confirmations. However, there was an 18.5% increase in the number of dismissals and a corresponding decrease in the conversions to other chapters. It is important to emphasize that these changes in the handling of chapter 11 cases occurred within the confines of the present Bankruptcy Code. The reduction in time to disposition of a chapter 11 case can be accomplished with absolutely no change in the statute of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure. It only requires judges to adopt judicial management techniques authorized by existing law. This Article does not suggest that the particular model of chapter 11 case management reported in this study, referred to as "fast track" management, is the only appropriate type of judicial chapter 11 case management, or even the best. This study reports on this particular fast track model

principally because it is the only model for which good data are available and because it is very effective in reducing delays in the chapter 11 process. For individuals, chapter 11 is more expensive and complicated than the much more common chapter 13 because the applicable rules are a hybrid of those that apply in chapter 13 and those that apply to entities in chapter 11. Some debtors may be forced into chapter 11 by chapter 13's debt limits, but many debtors who are eligible for chapter 13 choose chapter 11. Perhaps the hybrid nature of individual chapter 11 cases is justified because the individuals who use chapter 11 look like a blend of the typical chapter 13 debtor and a small business: they have much greater assets, debts, income and expenses, and the overwhelming majority are operating some type of business. Real estate also plays a significant role in chapter 11. We find that more than a third of individual chapter 11 debtors confirm a plan and avoid dismissal or conversion for at least 881 days, and that this rate is higher for jointly filed cases, cases filed by experienced attorneys and cases with substantial real estate. The rate is lower in cases filed pro se and cases in which the debtor does not expect to distribute assets to general creditors. We further find that involuntary chapter 11 cases are almost non-existent; the fear of involuntary servitude through bankruptcy is more of a theoretical than an empirical problem.
